I liked the lectures too, they were all a bit like seminars. The only problem with that, possibly, was that they did not really serve a common goal or followed a clear line throughout the course

2. What improvements would you suggest in the course?

What improvements would you suggest in the course?

The lab assistants should be correcting the two first lab exercises by the same standard. For one lab assistant a barely finished exercise lab report was ok and a pass, whereas for another you needed to revise it several times for minor things another one of the assistants would have passed.

Choose a standard and stick to it all three of you. Since the lab exercises could play a part in the final grade this seems a bit odd and should be improved for the next year.

It would have been good with some more information about PlaSim theory before the labs and the lecture about climate models could have been given earlier in the course.

Don't assume that everyone are good at programming

Even though I just said the independence was good, I do think that there should maybe have been a possibility for some more guidance and some more 'classical' teaching, so that everyone got to use the freedom in a satisfactory way. E.g. not only having the peer review, but also having for example two reviews along the way for which the teaching assistants give feedback, e.g. for a well-reported project plan (I know we had project plan help, but now it was more optional) and a first report version before peer review. In that way, the peer review would also be more useful, as it would force people to have a more end-version like report by that time. Now the peer review felt a bit useless, both to review and to receive reviews, because many reports were not at all in 'submittable' state.

And also, the lectures could have been a bit more coordinated. now, they did not really provide a buildup of knowledge throughout the course of any kind, any one of them were way too basic, whereas others were of a good, challenging level. So some more coordination with the lecturers would help.

3. What advice would you like to give to future course participants?

What advice would you like to give to future course participants?

Manage your time from the beginning of the course in order to investigate further your project.

Starting directly with the bigger project

Start thinking about the project early on.

Know how to use python

Even though you have a lot of time for the individual project, start writing things up and organising your results very early, because you will have enough time to generate a shitload of results and it's actually the organising, interpreting and writing that requires most effort and time, not the modelling or plotting.


Other comments

I was not really affected by this, but there seemed to be quite large differences in terms of the grading-habits of the three course assistants. Some quality reports were passed/not-passed differently and some reports needed revision many times and on very small details, whereas others were passed immediately and small details were merely pointed out, but did not lead to required revision. Might be good to have a general grading procedure the assistants stick to (maybe this is already there) and to let the assistants discuss the reports so that they can make sure everyone is graded by approximately the same standards (and so that they can correct each other).


Good course but there was a lot of repetition on weather and climate that some of us already knew






I think, with a bit more intermediate deadlines, the workload could and should be increased a bit, to also increase the quality of the students' work and the learning outcomes.






