That meant that we maybe didn't cover everything that was in the lecture plan initially, but we did gain much more complete and better understanding of the important concepts we did cover. More focus on surface waves and tides and differences in order to understand easily what kind of ways do we observe when we stand on a beach.

Even though the lectures were very enjoyable, the course now only consisted of lectures/exercises and an exam. There was an hour or so of 'practical' with a water tank, but not much applied work. Of course exercises are 'active', but still very theoretical. It might be nice to add a project-like component to the course, involving some modelling/application of theoretical concepts. E.g. a data-analysis+modelling lab could be very interesting. The large scale circulation course, for example, features several modelling assignments that would fit in this course as well (I'd recommend to not exactly copy them because some students will do both courses) and I think that it would suit this course to design an assignment focused on the analysis of measurement data (from some 'real' past study maybe?). This might also aid in providing the students with an idea of what working in oceanography might entail (because almost all courses at misu focus on the more atmospheric side of things). Also, even though repetition is always good, this course had a lot of overlap with previous courses (numerical modelling, modelling of large scale circulation and geophysical fluid dynamics). If the basics of the concepts that are already known to the students (e.g. Poincaré, Kelvin, Rossby waves, Sverdrup circulations, Munk & Stommel solutions) would be given a bit less time/attention, there

might be the opportunity to focus on more advanced/new/other material (e.g. the role of salinity, MOC/box models/multiple equilibria etc. are not covered in any other course). I am aware that the knowledge of students when they start the course might differ, so that would make things complicated, but I think definitely poicare, kelvin and rossby waves can be considered 'general knowledge' by the time students take this course, or it could be considered to make that a prerequisite.

Focus on what the different kinds of circulation and wave phenomena mean, how they arise and how they are calculated/derived mathematically

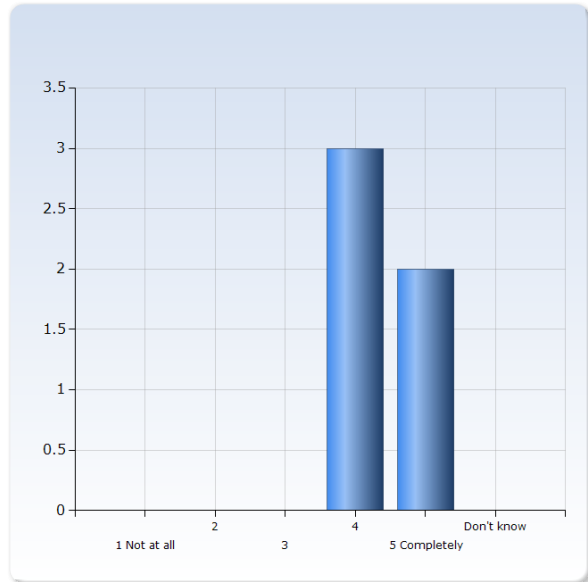

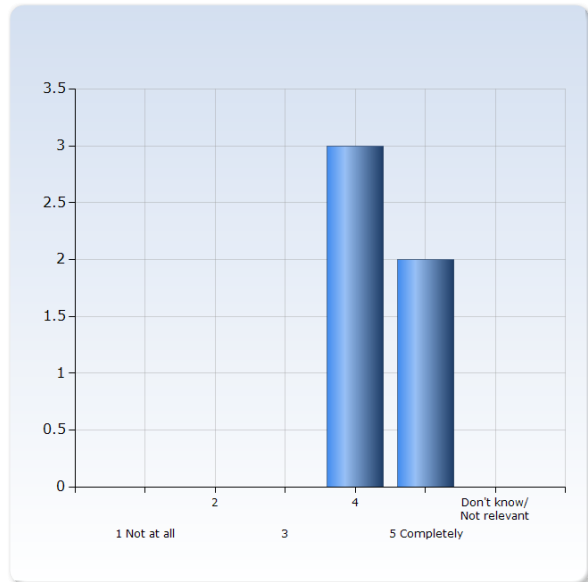

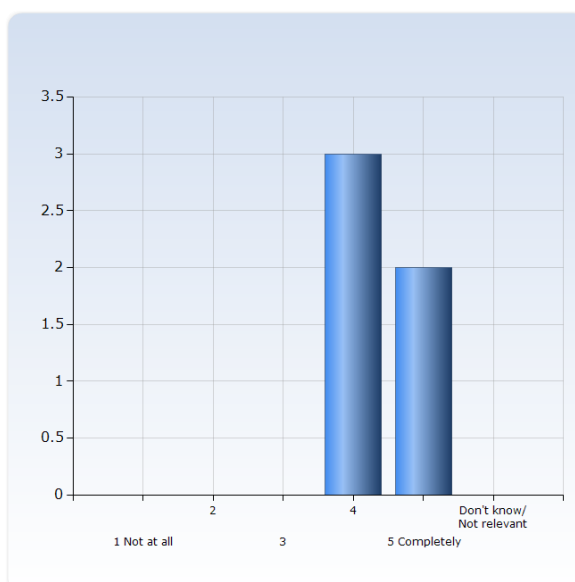

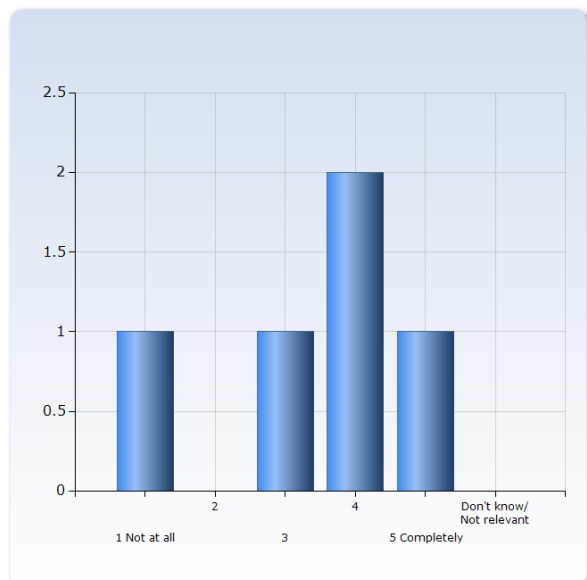
